As part of that exhibition, a photographic study of the characteristic external building details of the South Chatswood residential conservation area was undertaken.


These examples and subsequent pictures taken of other conservation or similar areas of Willoughby City form the basis of this exhibition.


This development substantially took place from the beginning of the 1900s to the 1930s - hence the title "After the Dawn" (of the 20th Century).

Additionally, while making these specific studies the opportunity was taken to record other items that form part of our everyday streetscape.









CHATSWOOD HOUSE NAMES SAMPLER




