
















Astraea College tennis players, 1911. College was located at Centennial Avenue, Chatswood




Chatswood Fire Station, firemen and fire engine, ca.1910- 1913. Station located at 767 Pacific Highway


Butcher Bros Brickyard, Hotham Parade, Artarmon, 1910s. Operated until the late 1940s

Arrival of first tram at Chatswood Railway Station, 1908









Reopening of Northbridge Suspension Bridge with concrete arches, 1939




