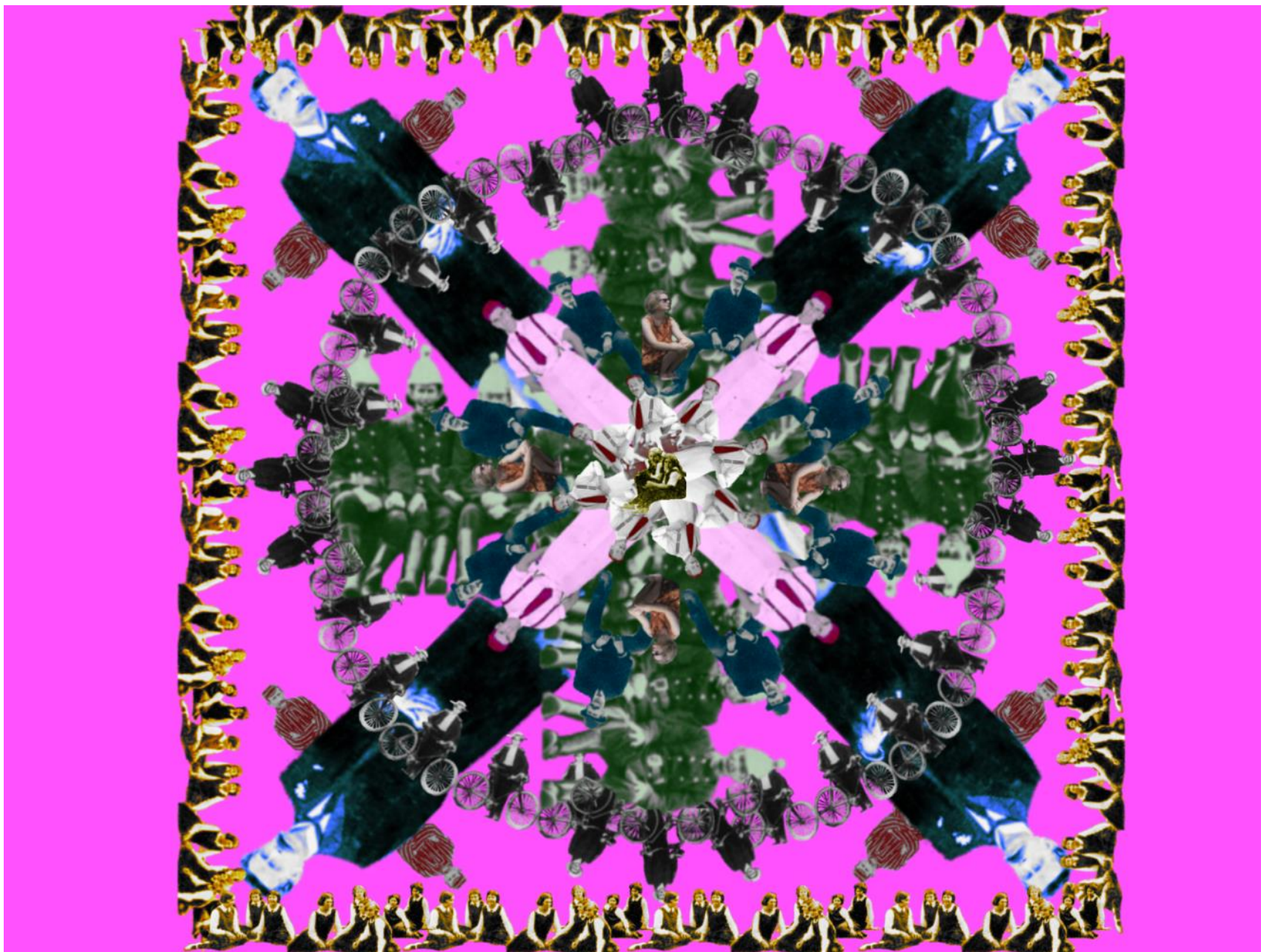

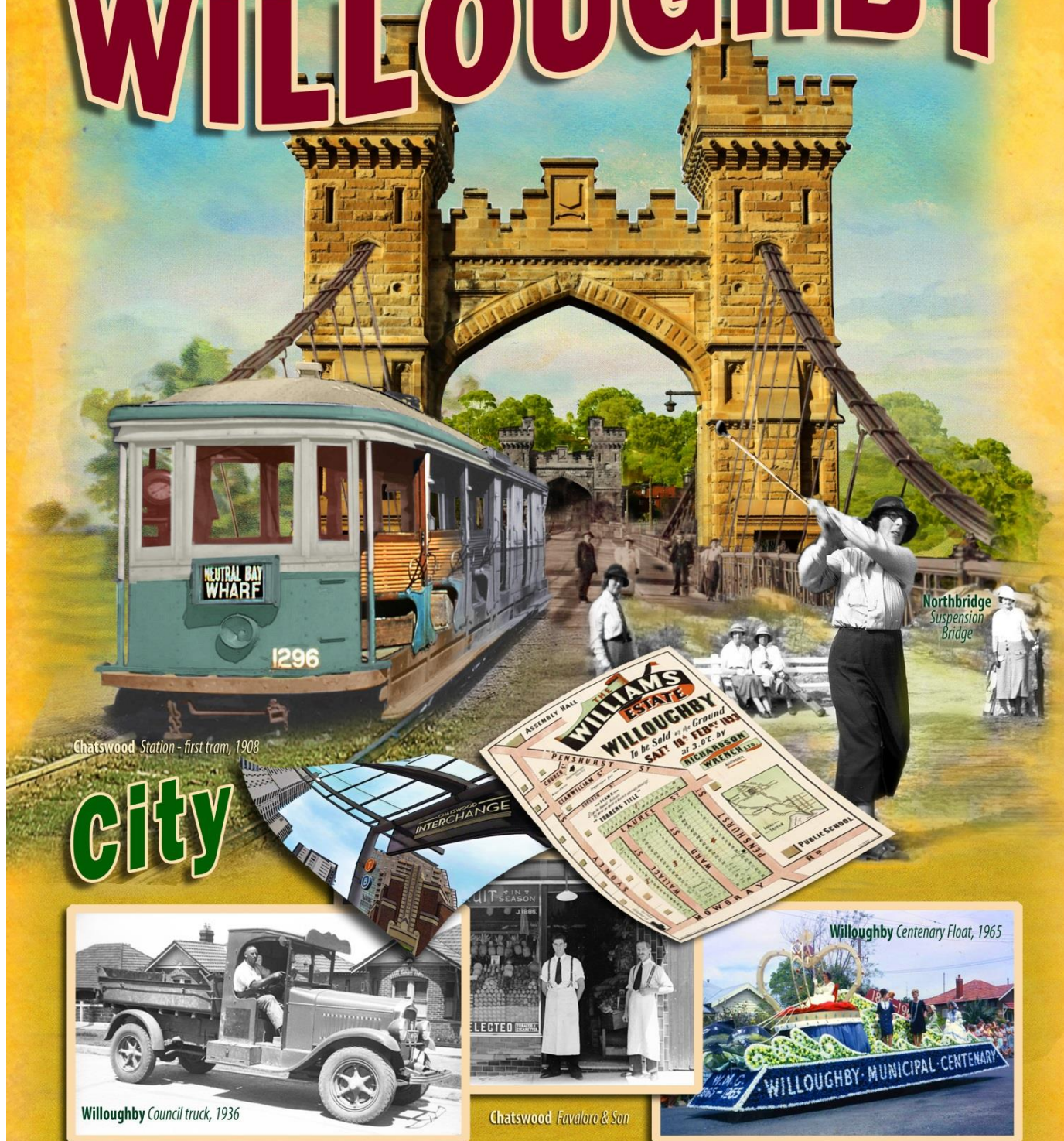

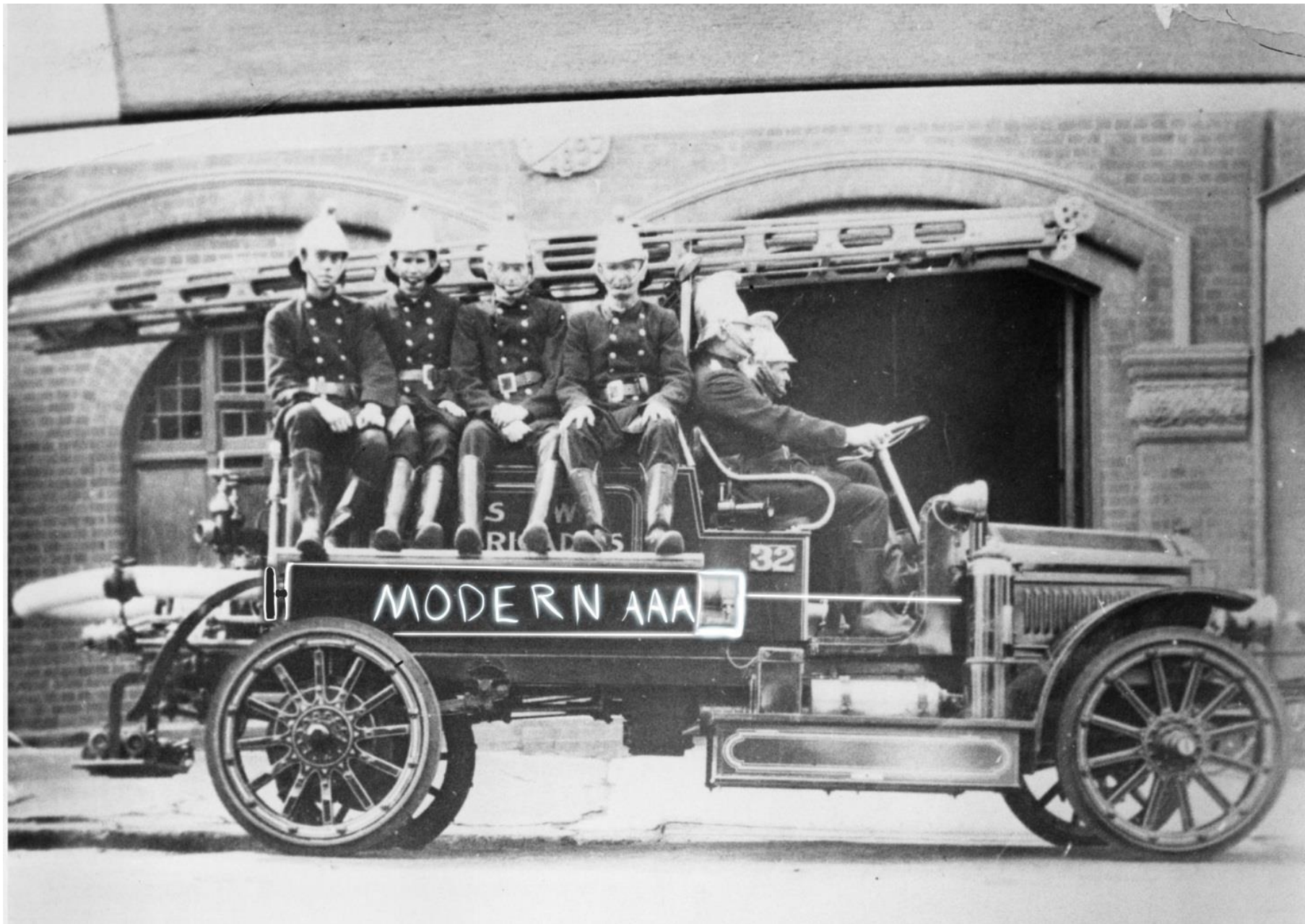

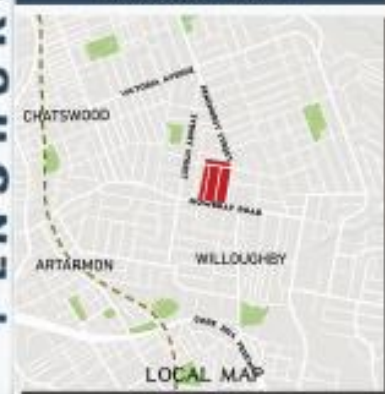

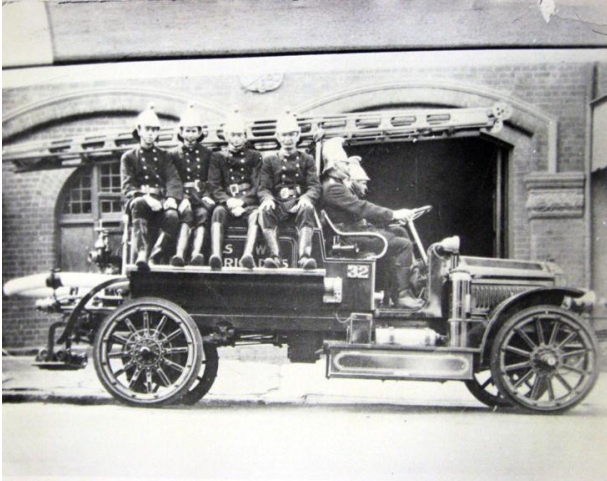

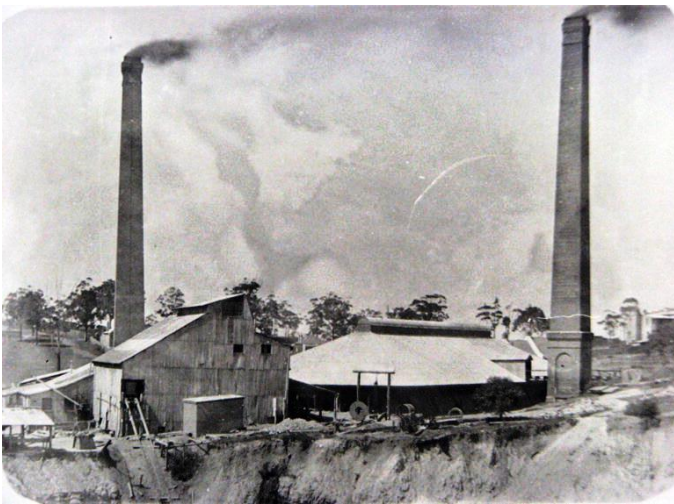

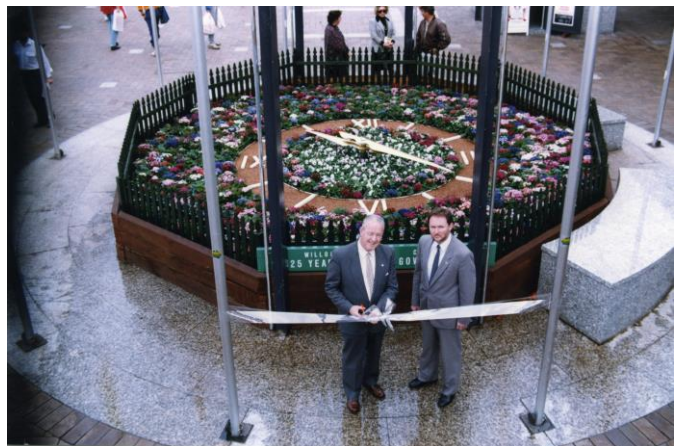
'The Grange', 35 Gibbes Street, Chatswood, ca.1910

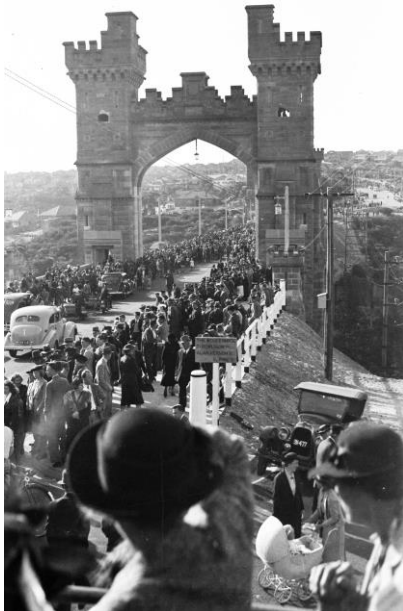

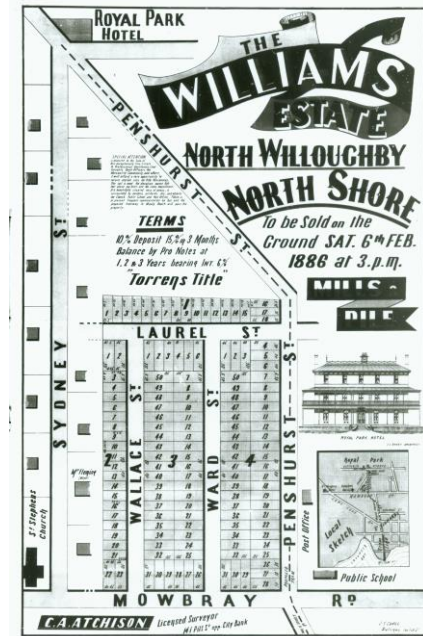

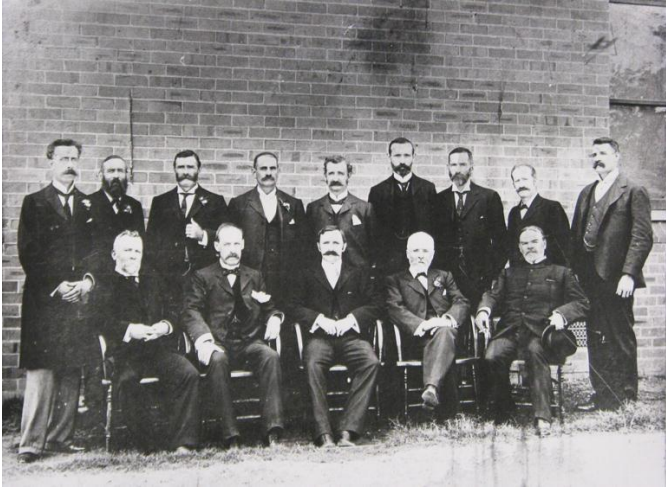
